



## COARSE FISHING

Furzemill Pond operates as a mixed coarse fishery. The pond is stocked with Bream, Tench, Rudd and three different species of Carp.

Fishing is from the pegs and the dam area only.

We have a platform available for the disabled angler – please check availability before your visit.

Far side of the lake, opposite the dam and pegs, there is a conservation area where there is strictly no fishing.

Permits may be purchased at the entrance kiosk. Please retain your receipt as proof of payment.

### Parking

There are a limited number of spaces available at the rear of the Castle Courtyard. Parking near the lake for registered disabled anglers may be available by arrangement on arrival at the entry kiosk.

Every effort will be made to assist fishermen within our limited parking capacity.

Fishermen are asked whilst driving through the park to adhere to the 15mph speed limit and ensure that hazard light are on at all times.

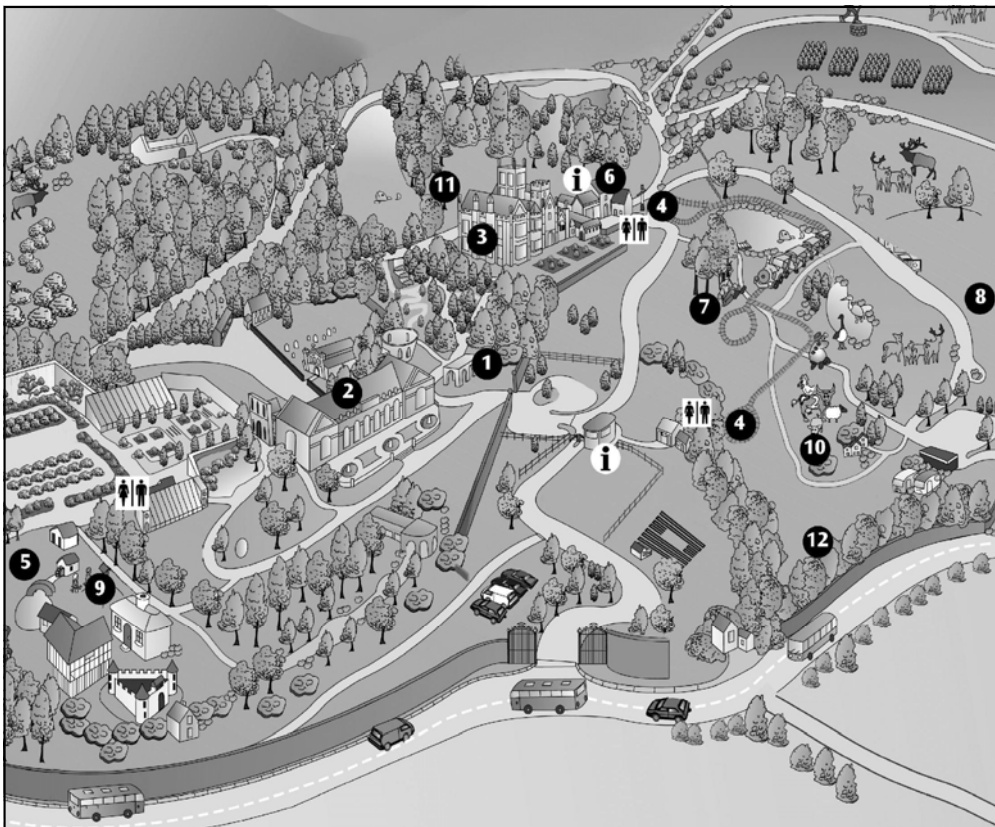
## GUIDELINES & REGULATIONS

- ◆ A current Environmental Agency (NRA) licence is required, and must be shown at the time of permit purchase.
- ◆ Maximum of 2 rods per Angler.
- ◆ Anglers under 14 yrs must be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ There is a maximum of 8 anglers per day at Furzemill Pond. (Juniors included).
- ◆ Fishing and ground baiting with baits such as BOILIES, TIGER NUTS AND PEANUTS are strictly prohibited at all times.
- ◆ No spinning allowed. Barbless hooks only.
- ◆ The lighting of fires is prohibited. Please take your litter and discarded tackle home with you. Please respect the Countryside and Wildlife.
- ◆ The Park Management reserve the right to search bags / baskets should it be deemed necessary to do so.
- ◆ The Park Management reserve the right to stop fishing at any time without prior notice.

Any angler failing to comply with the above regulations will asked to leave the Park.

Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council also reserve the right to change any of the above regulations without prior notice.
